3. Background

- 3.1 At the IJB meeting of the 26th January 2017, a request was made from Scottish Care to have a non-voting membership of the IJB.

Scottish Care is a national membership organisation which provides 100% of care home services and circa 70% of care at home services throughout Dumfries and Galloway.

The IJB were happy to support this recommendation.

4. Main Body of the Report

- 4.1 Following the decision at the IJB on the 26th January 2017, Julie White, wrote to Dr Donald Macaskill, Chief Executive of Scottish Care, to ask for a nomination from the Organisation for a non-voting member to sit on the Integration Joint Board.
