

INVESTING IN WIGTOWNSHIRE



Galloway Community Hospital opened in 2007 at a cost of **£12.5 million**.

The annual running cost, not including the Out-Of-Hours Service, is **£5.8 million**.



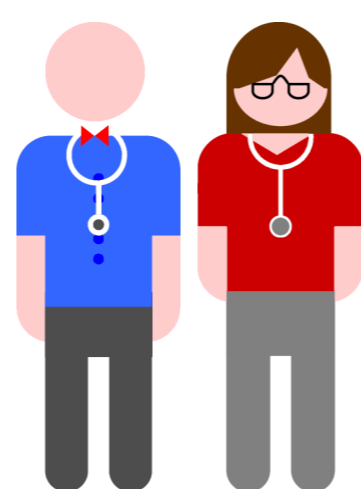
£90,000

is being spent to upgrade the renal dialysis unit.

£200,000

is being spent to upgrade the operating theatres and endoscopy facilities at Galloway Community Hospital.

£1.5 million has been spent on temporary medical staff for the Galloway Community Hospital during 2016/17.



£14.9 million is spent running community based services across Wigtownshire.



The total cost of medication dispensed during 2016/17 through primary care in Wigtownshire was **£6.9 million**.

The average annual cost per person on medication was **£300**.

The average across the rest of Dumfries & Galloway is **£245**.



£150,000 is being spent to enhance nursing within Wigtownshire.

1 Advanced Nurse Practitioner (ANP) and 1 trainee ANP are supporting delivery of medical care within Galloway Community Hospital.

A **new** role of **Clinical Nurse Manager** has recently been appointed at Galloway Community Hospital.

2 ANPs have recently been recruited to support the **Out-Of-Hours** service.

£514,000 has been spent on providing temporary locum GPs for the Out-Of-Hours service in Wigtownshire during 2016/17
