



ANNANDALE AND ESKDALE POPULATION PROFILE (2)


There are **1,410 people** from Annandale and Eskdale living in areas recognised nationally as being amongst the **most deprived** in Scotland.

Information from **Scotland's Census 2011** about the population of **Annandale and Eskdale** tells us

21% of households have no access to a car or van 

5% of households have a lone parent 

322 households have no central heating

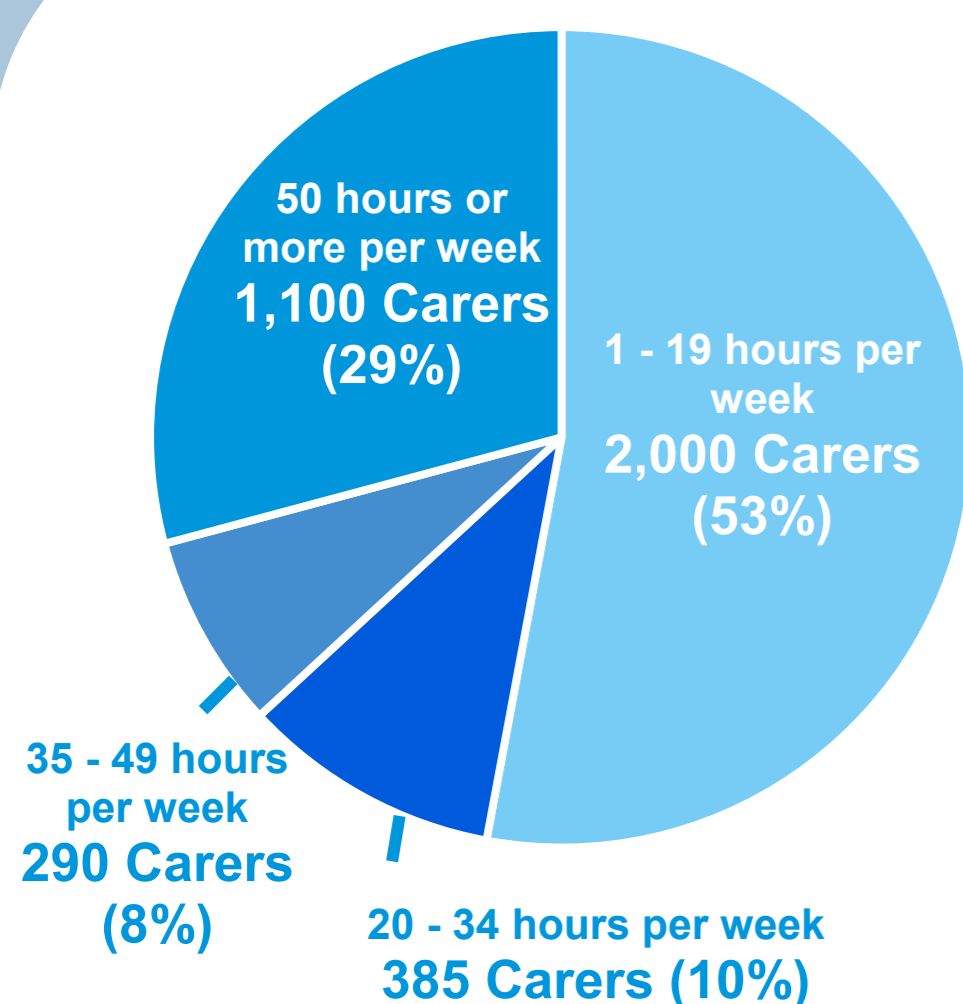
12,120 people have at least 1 long term condition 

2,660 people are aged over 65 years and live alone

Across Annandale and Eskdale **1 in 10 people** are Carers and provide **unpaid care** for a close friend or relative.

This is equivalent to **3,800** people.

Carers



1 in 3 Carers from Annandale and Eskdale provides more than 50 hours of unpaid care per week

900 Carers from Annandale and Eskdale are aged 65 years or older

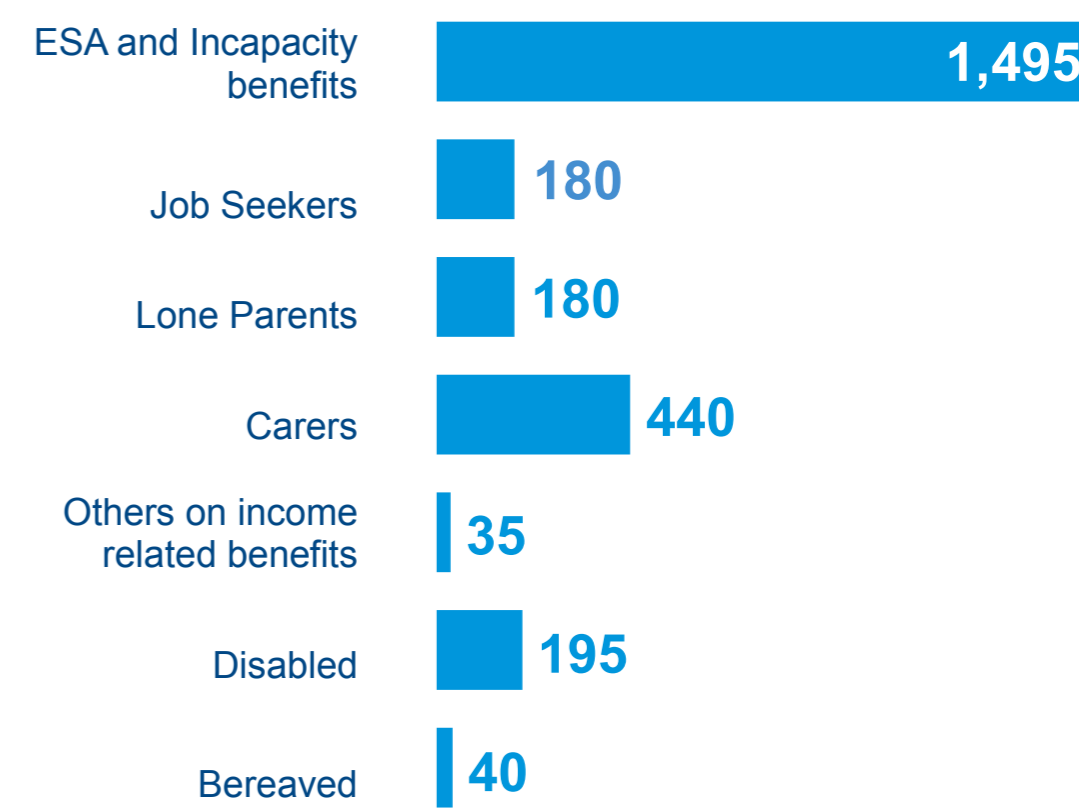
7% of Carers from Annandale and Eskdale report being in 'bad' or 'very bad' health (270 people)

11% of working age people (16 to 64 yrs) from Annandale and Eskdale receive benefits.

This is equivalent to **2,570** people.

Working Age Benefit Claimants

Approximately **2,150 people** are receiving universal credit.

In Annandale and Eskdale **46% of women** and **55% of men** aged 16 to 34 have **low or no qualifications**.

Life Expectancy

Across Annandale and Eskdale the lowest life expectancy for **men** is **77.3 years** (Annandale East), and for **women** is **79.6 years** (Lockerbie).
