

### Q1 Are you a Carer


# Q2 As a Carer, does the Local Eligibility Framework explain the different levels of support you might receive in the future, and how it will be decided?

Colour coded risk chart on pages 3 & 4 does not allow for different risk levels to be associated with different areas of carer's life. Section 5 is too simplistic (page 6 carer rarely envisages likely longer term risks at early stage when optimum solutions could be established allowing for progression of risk and circumstances). Section 6 ALARP triangle should be time dependent if long term eligibility can be determined at an early stage then more cost beneficial solutions can be adopted at an earlier stage instead of critical interventions when risk has already reached the highest risk situation.	11/18/2017 5:02 PM

The criteria is limited; for example, although my health isn't 'at risk' I suffer immense hip pain but because of my caring role, I can't seek health care to deal with the pain - I can't be 'non-weight bearing for two weeks as there is no one else here to care for my child. My health isn't 'at risk' but it is impacted negatively by my role. There is also no consideration for outside factors that impact on my ability to care - harassment by the neighbours. 




### Q12 How would you describe your gender?










